


2) I'm Standing on a Million Lives Genre-Isekai, Game, Fantasy, Action

WRITTEN AND ILLUSTRATED BY OSAMU NISHI. MAIRIMASHITA! IRUMA-KUN IS AN ONGOING JAPANESE MANGA, PUBLISHED BY AKITA SHOTEN IN THE MAGAZINE WEEKLY SHONEN CHAMPION EVERY THURSDAY. IT IS AVAILABLE DIGITALLY AND CAN BE BOUGHT FROM MULTIPLE VENDORS. AS OF YET, NO OFFICIAL ENGLISH TRANSLATIONS EXIST, BUT THIRD PARTY TRANSLATORS HAVE MADE IT AVAILABLE IN ENGLISH. THE MANGAKA HAS WRITTEN ANOTHER SERIES BEFORE, HOTEL HELHEIM, SERIALIZED IN JUMP SQ. THERE IS ONE MANGA SPINOFF, MAKAI NO SHUYAKU WA WAREWARE DA!, WHICH IS CO-AUTHORED BY KONESHIMA AND CO-ILLUSTRATED BY ATSUSHI TSUDANUMA. IT TAKES PLACE IN THE SAME WORLD AS THAT OF MAIRIMASHITA! IRUMA-KUN, BUT IT FOCUSES ON THE EVENTS OF DIFFERENT CHARACTERS NOT FEATURED IN THE MAIN SERIES. THE MANGA IS MAINLY SET IN NETHERWORLD(MAKAI), A WORLD SEPARATE FROM THAT OF HUMANS, POPULATED BY DEMONS AND MAGICAL BEASTS, AND FILLED WITH MAGIC. HUMANS ARE CONSIDERED MYTHICAL CREATURES AND MOST DEMONS AREN'T AWARE OF THEIR EXISTENCE. **DEMONS ARE CHARACTERISED BY THEIR** COMPULSION TO FOLLOW THEIR DESIRE WITHOUT ANY CAUTION. THIS RESULTS IN SELFISHNESS AND VIOLENCE BEING THEIR DOMINANT NATURE. IRUMA IS A 14 YEAR OLD HUMAN BOY WHO IS SOLD TO A DEMON BY HIS PARENTS. THE DEMON, SULLIVAN, TAKES HIM TO THE NETHERWORLD WHERE HE ADOPTS IRUMA AS HIS GRANDSON AND HE IS ENROLLED INTO DEVIL SCHOOL BABYLS. THE STORY IS BUILT UP AROUND IRUMA, HIS CLASSMATES AND FOLLOWS THE EVENTS WHICH UNFORTUNATELY MAKE HIM STAND OUT. WHY IS IT UNFORTUNATE? THIS IS DUE TO A LITTLE FACT THAT EVEN THOUGH **HUMANS ARE CONSIDERED NON-EXISTENT. THEY ARE** HEAVILY IMPLIED TO BE FOOD IN DEMON LORE. IRUMA. BEING A HUMAN AND AWARE OF THIS. TRIES HIS BEST TO NOT STAND OUT BUT FAILS TO DO SO EVERY TIME. THE EVENTS ARE FOCUSED ON THE AMBITIONS OF THE CHARACTERS AND THEIR STRUGGLE AS THEY PROGRESS TOWARDS THEIR GOAL.



THE AUTHOR HAS DONE A COMMENDABLE JOB OF SETTING UP INTERESTING PLOT POINTS INDICATING THERE IS MORE TO NETHERWORLD THAN WHAT MEETS THE EYE TILL NOW. THE PACING OF THE STORY IS A BIT SLOW, BUT ON THE PLUS SIDE IT GIVES THE AUTHOR A CHANCE TO FLESH OUT THE STORY. AS A RESULT, AROUND 200 CHAPTERS HAVE BEEN SPENT ONLY IN THE FIRST YEAR OF IRUMA'S SCHOOL LIFE. FROM ALL INDICATIONS, IT SEEMS LIKE THIS IS GOING TO BE A VERY LONG-RUNNING MANGA AS EVEN THE NETHERWORLD SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN **EXPLORED BARELY TILL NOW. THOUGH THIS** SHOULD NOT GIVE YOU THE WRONG IDEA THAT THIS IS GOING TO BE A BORING STORY -ON THE CONTRARY IT IS ACTUALLY A VERY ENGAGING READ. WHAT STANDS OUT MOST IS THE SUBTLE HUMOUR PRESENT IN THIS MANGA THAT LENDS TO A PLEASANT READING EXPERIENCE.

BLACK CLOVER HAS A SIMPLISTIC YET COMPLEX STORY THAT DRAWS US IN AND MAKES US INVESTED IN THE WORLD THAT THE ANIME HAS CREATED. THE ANIME AT SOME POINT BECOMES PREDICTABLE BUT STILL IT DOESN'T FAIL TO GIVE YOU CHILLS. IT'S AMAZING HOW MUCH THE AUTHOR HAS ACCOMPLISHED WHEN HE JUST STARTED THE STORY WITH TWO KIDS WITH THE SAME DREAM TO BECOME THE WIZARD KING. BESIDES THE PROTAGONISTS, THE AUTHOR HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY ABLE TO CREATE AN EXPANSIVE, DEVELOPED AND FLESHED OUT WORLD, WITH DIFFERENT KINGDOMS AND CLASSES OF OPERATIVES, THE KINGDOMS FIGHTING EACH OTHER AND THE CLOVER KINGDOM HAVING NINE DIFFERENT SQUADS OF MAGIC KNIGHTS PROTECTING THE KINGDOM.

THIS ANIME ALSO HAS AN INSANE CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT WHERE EACH INDIVIDUAL CHARACTER IS GIVEN A GOOD AMOUNT OF DETAIL AND ATTENTION, THE SIDE CHARACTERS HAVE GOT THEIR BACK STORY EXPLAINED WITH EVERYONE OF THEM HAVING A PROPER CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, CREATING A SENSE THAT THE SHOW ISN'T JUST ABOUT ONE OR TWO PEOPLE, WHICH ONLY ADDS TO THE WORLD BUILDING. OUR LEAD ASTA HAS A CLEAR-CUT GOAL, TO NEVER GIVE UP AND BECOME THE WIZARD KING. THE SHOW DOESN'T LET US FORGET THAT, OR THAT YUNO IS THE SAME, BOTH YUNO AND ASTA HAVE VERY CONTRASTING CHARACTERISTICS WHERE ASTA BEING LOUD, NOISY, FRIENDLY AND DUMB AND YUNO BEING QUITE, SMART AND WAY COOLER ATTITUDE. STILL NO MATTER WHERE THEY ARE OR HOW DIFFERENT THEY ARE, THE OTHER IS STILL THEIR RIVAL AND BEST FRIEND/BROTHER. THIS ANIME IS FILLED WITH CHARACTERS MAKING MOTIVATIONAL STATEMENTS WHERE ONE OF MY FAVOURITES IS CAPTAIN FUEGOLEON VERMILLION STATING "BEING WEAK IS NOTHING TO BE ASHAMED OF... STAYING WEAK IS" WHICH CLEARLY MOTIVATES THE WATCHERS TO OVERCOME THEIR CHALLENGES AND DIFFICULTIES IN REAL LIFE.

THE ANIMATION AND ART OF THIS ANIME IS QUITE GOOD AT NON-ACTION SCENES, BUT IT DISAPPOINTS A LITTLE AT ACTION SCENES. THE ANIMATION SHOULD HAVE BEEN BETTER AS EXPECTED FROM A NEW GENERATION ANIME, THOUGH THE ANIMATION QUALITY IS IMPROVING DAY BY DAY. THE LATEST RELEASED EPISODES HAVE QUITE GOOD ANIMATION COMPARED TO ITS INITIAL EPISODES' FIGHT SCENES.

NOW COMES ONE OF THE BEST PARTS - THE MUSIC AND THE OST. BLACK CLOVER HAS ONE OF THE BEST OPENING SONGS OF ALL TIME WHERE EVERY OPENING IS A BANGER. 13 OPENINGS. HAVE BEEN RELEASED SO FAR, AND ALL OF THEM ARE EXCELLENT. THE MOST POPULAR OPENING AMONG THE FANS IS **CURRENTLY THE OPENING #10 (VICKEBLANKA - BLACK** CATCHER). ONE OF THE QUALITIES OF ITS OPENINGS IS THAT IT TRIES TO GIVE YOU VERY LITTLE SPOILERS OF THE ANIME. UNLIKE OTHER ANIME WHICH SPOIL SOME SCENES OF THEIR ARCS IN THE OPENINGS. TO MAKE THINGS EVEN MORE ENJOYABLE, BLACK CLOVER HAS MULTIPLE VERSIONS OF THE SAME OPENING. THE VERSION OF OPENING CHANGES AFTER SOME EPISODES, BY ADDING NEW MAJOR SCENES FROM THE PREVIOUS EPISODES, SO THAT VIEWERS WON'T GET SPOILED. THE OST PLAYING DURING THE FIGHT SCENES COMPLETELY SYNCS WITH THE ACTION AND LETS YOU EXPERIENCE THE EMOTIONS OF THE CHARACTERS DURING THE SCENE.

I WOULD LIKE TO END BY SAYING THAT BLACK CLOVER IS A THOROUGHLY FUN SHOW TO WATCH WITH A SIMPLE STORY. THE SHOW AS WHOLE GETS YOU HOOKED UP AND REFUSES TO LET YOU GO. YOU WILL FIND YOURSELF LAUGHING, SMILING AND GETTING SHIVERS THROUGHOUT THE SHOW - AND ENJOYING THE EXCITEMENT.

SUMMARY

The story centres on a young woman named Shirayuki, who is well known for her work as an herbalist and her red hair. Nobody in her country of Tanbarun has such red hair, and this makes her the centre of unwanted attention. When the moronic Prince Raj falls in love with her and wants to make her his concubine, she refuses to let herself be subjected to a cruel fate, so she gives him the middle finger by cutting her hair and runs away to the next kingdom, Clarines, as she has nowhere else to go. While traversing through the forests, she finds herself befriending the crown prince of Clarines, Zen, who offers to let her into his kingdom to protect her from Raj. She isn't quite sure what his intentions are, but she does want to pay her debt to him, so she becomes a court herbalist in his castle. With this, her adventures in the Clarines kingdom begin.





CHARACTERS

The relationship between the characters is what this show is all about. Or well, to be more accurate. It is what makes the show special and great to watch. Shirayuki is completely different from the usual heroines that are commonly in this type of demographic. She's very clever, independent of what she does and holds responsibility for what she does and tries to repay any favour that she may hold to anyone. She is not there to be saved and protected for romantic moments, she holds her own and tries her best to be in the same line as the male main lead. Her boldness and ability to solve situations on her own is nothing short of amazing! The same falls for other characters. Most of the characters showed how multidimensional their characteristics are instead of being one dimensional character. Character developments are thankfully still open for the continuation of this series.

ART AND ANIMATION

The art and animation of the series is incredibly exquisite. As expected from a studio that is well known for its gorgeous visuals, Bones. It does not follow the usual colorization that someone would expect from this type of show. Yet it fits it perfectly. The colours are bright and the animation is slick, smooth and relaxing.

MUSIC

It basically contains relaxing songs. In all it has four songs — Two opening and two closing songs in two seasons. My personal favourite is Sono Koe ga Chizu ni Naru by Saori Hayami.



ENJOYMENT

Akagami no Shirayuki-hime is an anime that is incredibly easy to watch through. It's light and warm. The interactions between the characters are interesting and the dialogue rarely leaves the person to be bored or feel that it is being dull. It may have its moments that feel "cheesy" on book, but the way it is approached is what makes it gorgeous and beautiful to watch. 
REVIEW - NO GAME NO LIFE
